

Round 1 Interview: HAROLD VARNER III

Q. Here with Harold Varner. You're making your debut here in Puerto Rico and an early round of 66. Talk us through the round today.

HAROLD VARNER III: Just hit it really well today. I got a lot of looks and just one little blemish on the card. Obviously it's gettable right now in the morning because there was oddly no wind all day today. Just got to keep getting after it, you know. It's kind of weird weather, but I don't control that part of it.

Q. Third year on the PGA Tour, incrementally getting better and better. Talk about the experiences and how beneficial they are now that you are in the field here?

HAROLD VARNER III: You know, I don't really think much of it but it just helps, you know, I've been with the same caddie. Just kind of try and do the things that help me play well and that's getting the ball in play and attack from the fairway. I've been hitting it a little wild lately.
