

**Round 2 Interview: D.A. POINTS**

**Q. 3-under 68 and I'm sure the most --**

**D.A. POINTS:** 69.

**Q. I'm sorry, 3-under 69. I know you're glad to get it done, first of all.**

**D.A. POINTS:** Yes, for sure.

**Q. Dinner will taste a little better. I know the round's not done yet, but nice to finish right at 11?**

**D.A. POINTS:** Yeah, I didn't hit it as close today as I did yesterday, but we had a little more wind today and just wasn't as dialed in. But I was really proud the way I finished, birdieing 16 and 18, and 3 under on a day when I didn't have my best stuff is good.

**Q. To kind of follow up on that, after a day like yesterday, do you try to just come right back in and just do the same type of thing given you've also had stops and starts and weather delays, does it kind of creep into your head or are you at the point in your career where you kind of level that out?**

**D.A. POINTS:** Well, I don't know if you can totally level it out. You know, sometimes when you shoot an 8-under round or have a really low round, some really cool things happen.

It was funny, on the first hole today I hit a really nice putt from about 40 feet that went right in the middle and somehow came right out the front and all the guys in the group just kind of laughed at me. They were like, "That hole knew you holed out yesterday to finish the round." That was kind of how the day started. But I stayed patient and really didn't play poorly, hit a lot of fairways, hit a lot of greens and then finally holed a couple putts coming in.

**Q. Finally, speaking of patience, could be some more stopping and starting as the weekend goes on. You just keep doing what you're doing, I guess?**

**D.A. POINTS:** Yeah, this is the first time in a while that I've been this close to the lead after two days, so I'm just proud of myself for being in that position to begin with. Then really we'll just see what happens. I don't have a whole lot of preconceived ideas about how the weather's going to be. I know it's going to rain and I know there's going to be some wind, and we'll just do what we have.
