

**Round 3 Interview: D.A. POINTS**  
**March 25, 2017**

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**Q. So D.A., great round today.**

**D.A. POINTS:** Thank you.

**Q. Ball-striking has been a forte this week, was that the case again today?**

**D.A. POINTS:** Yeah, I hit a lot of greens, maybe not as close as I would like to to the pin, but again, I am not at all disappointed with how I'm playing. I hit a lot of great putts, especially the last, gosh, like six or seven holes and didn't hole much. So if I can get a couple of those to fall tomorrow, I'll be in good shape.

**Q. We've got a crowded leaderboard. What's it going to take for you to separate yourself from the pack?**

**D.A. POINTS:** Well, you're going to have to get it close to the hole and make some putts. I'm not sure what the weather will be like. The last few mornings have been pretty calm and then this morning it was blowing decently, so we'll have to see tomorrow. If it's going to be blowing, it will be a lot of just really quality solid shots and not getting maybe too greedy. But then if the weather's real calm, it's hit as close as you can and make as many as you can.

**Q. It's got to be an exciting feeling knowing that you're going to be in one of last groups tomorrow in position to get a win.**

**D.A. POINTS:** Yeah, you know, the nice thing is I don't feel like I'm playing out of my head. I'm not holing a crazy amount of putts and I'm not doing anything really extra special. I'm hitting it in the fairway, I'm hitting it on the green and I make one here or there. To be, I guess, maybe one shot back and in the final group, I feel really good because I kind of feel like I'm due to have one more kind of hot round.
