

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: SCOTT McCARRON (-15)
May 21, 2017



SCOTT McCARRON: I had like 235 or something like that to the hole into the wind uphill and I absolutely just smashed a 3-wood. I don't know what happened, I think I blanked out or something and just killed it up in the grandstands, and then had a very fast putt there. I three-putted that hole twice now this week doing the same thing. It just gets so fast around the hole. I just didn't play that well today, but certainly a nice little finish with a couple birdies coming in but I had three three-putts today. The long putter felt like holding a live snake in my hands all day, it was terrible.

Q. And you were so close, just hitting the tarp isn't the worst thing, you just missed --

SCOTT McCARRON: Yeah, I was trying to kind of one-hop bank it like I did the first round, but I just absolutely smashed it. That's the way it goes. Came up a little short.

Q. Would you have figured 15 under and you're five strokes back?

SCOTT McCARRON: No, I knew I would have to shoot really low today. And I played well enough to do it, I just didn't putt well enough. Langer's just, when he gets going, he's tough to beat, so hats off to him again.
