FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: KEVIN SUTHERLAND (-13) June 10, 2017



Q. So exciting way to finish the tournament. Tell me about this last shot on 18.

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Yeah, I was in a really good spot in the fairway kind of looking up at the green. I had 46 yards and I hit it just right. I landed it just on the green and sometimes it goes like you want it to and it just spun right into the hole. There's a lot of luck involved. I hit a really good shot.

Q. You've been in a good position many times, coming up short again, but do you still take a lot of positives away from a good tournament like this?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Yeah, I mean, I do. Obviously a little disappointed. The double bogey on 9 was a killer. And I shot 33 on the back nine, but then I bogeyed 10 and that kind of set me back. I kind of got back to where I was like 2 back and making the eagle on the last hole was not unforeseen. But I needed to make a few more birdies coming in, who knows what happens. You know what, it was a good week and it's all you can do.

Q. This is your eighth top-10 of the season. Are you happy with where you are so far midway through the season?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: Yeah, I'm playing good. I'm hitting a lot of good shots. For the most part, I've been putting pretty good. Yeah, I have no real complaints about how I played. I have two seconds. I mean, I need to get in the winner's circle. If you keep playing good, eventually it will happen.
