DUSTIN JOHNSON (-2)



Q. Dustin Johnson, how would you assess your round?

DUSTIN JOHNSON: Not very good. I putted well, I did roll the putter well, but other than that, just too many bad shots.

Q. When do you decide where to go for it or when to decide, hey, I've got to play it safe?

DUSTIN JOHNSON: Well, today wasn't really swinging that well so I had to kind of -- you know, I just tried to play the percentages, just tried to get looks at birdie as much as I could. But I didn't drive it too well today, that was the key for me, not driving it well.

Q. (No microphone.)

DUSTIN JOHNSON: I had some really good holes, I had some really bad holes. Yeah, I felt like I was just struggling all day, just grinding. But I did putt pretty well. I felt like I rolled the putter really nicely. When I did have good looks, I made them, which definitely kept my score at least respectable. Shooting 2 under, it's not terrible around here. The way I hit it, I probably should not have shot 2 under.

Q. Guys talk about distance control here with the altitude (No microphone.)

DUSTIN JOHNSON: No, I did pretty well with that. I just was not hitting the ball where I was looking, that was the problem.
