JORDAN SPIETH (- 1)



JORDAN SPIETH: You know, it's just the greens get bumpy. Sometimes you hit good putts and they miss. You've got to be really patient on poa annua. On these greens you have so many putts that are so straight because of the shelves that they can move either way. So had a couple tough breaks today, but it was a nice finish to be at 1 under. Going to need to obviously have a couple strong rounds the next two days to have a chance.

Q. And having that 63 here last year, what's been the difference in your mind, do you think, with trying to get back to a score like that?

JORDAN SPIETH: It's close, I just need everything to match. I actually hit the ball really well today. If I putted well, it would have been a 5 under round or something like that. Really got to take advantage of the par 5s to shoot a low score out here, and I was 1 over on the three par 5s. So that's a big difference in being able to post an extremely low round.
