BUBBA WATSON (-7)



BUBBA WATSON: (in progress) through the fairway and made a double there. So it wasn't a bad round. The ability was there, the talent was there. I just cleaned it up today, that's all it was. I just hit a couple better shots today.

Q. More comfortable with the distances? Do you have a formula dialed in? Do you let Teddy do that or is that a cooperation?

BUBBA WATSON: Yeah, we have a cheat sheet. We were in the room doing a bunch of homework. When I say we, it was Teddy doing a bunch of homework. He was making sure all the numbers were right. We have all the numbers, we can look at a little cheat sheet that we made. You know, it's just getting everything right. I mean, my ball striking is there. Today again my distances were better, played a little safer on a couple shots that I messed up yesterday, so it worked out.

Q. You lead the tournament in strokes gained off the tee, that's not a big surprise, but you also lead the tournament with 12 birdies. That's the best of the field. You're taking advantage of those drives?

BUBBA WATSON: Yeah, for sure. I made the putts, that's the key. Anybody in the top 10, anybody winning is making putts or they're chipping in a lot, so I'm going to say it's putting. So I made a few putts and it's been good.
