

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW

TYRRELL HATTON (- 15)

Q. You came to the 18th hole in the middle of the fairway tied for the lead. Can you walk us through the process there?

TYRRELL HATTON: Yeah, we were -- trying to think -- 148 meters. Wrong club. So it's just disappointing. Need a shot in there to take the spin off and we hit a club that's pitching around the pin if I hit a really good one and it's just going to spin. So I'm absolutely raging with that. And then probably in the most prolific (inaudible) I've ever seen with a putt. I mean, it's a downhill putt, you can hit it soft and it's pretty much (inaudible.) I'm pretty hacked off. We'll see, you never know when you're going to get the chance to win a WGC event again. This is the first chance I've had of winning. So but I got really unlucky on 6 and then the par 5, and then got unlucky again on 11. I didn't even hit a bad shot on 11 and I walk off with 6. So I can't believe that I'm not at least in the playoff, I've played good enough, thought I handled the situation pretty well. Guess it just wasn't meant to be.

Q. Very tough breaks. Explain what happened on 18.

TYRRELL HATTON: Yeah, the greens weren't rolling great, even more so when you're out last, it's tricky to hole putts. Felt like I did a pretty good job of that, but the one on 18 was just a joke. Can't be having that in a WGC event. I'm sorry, but...

You know, it's a downhill putt, I'm going to hit it soft and it's just going straight up in the air as soon as you hit it. I mean, I can't do anything about that. Obviously disappointing, and disappointed I hit the wrong club going for the second shot. So you don't get many opportunities to win WGC events and I feel like I've thrown a really good opportunity away. So I'm pretty upset, definitely angry. Don't know how else to sum up really.

Q. I don't know the last time on Sunday when we've seen the leader -- leadership change so much. Did you have any kind of emotional roller coaster, especially going into that back nine?

TYRRELL HATTON: Yeah, it was up and down. I mean, felt like I was pretty unlucky today in general, especially on 6. It was a really poor drive but I was right up against the tree. I feel (inaudible) the drive and he stays off the tree near the fairway and he gets on the green in 2. So guess you need breaks like that from time to time. Felt like I got unlucky down 11 as well, another par 5. Didn't hit a bad shot there and walk off with 6. Just wasn't my day today.
