Q. So 6-under today, Top of the Rock, you're at -12. Give me thoughts on how it went out there for you despite the cold and the wind.

PAUL BROADHURST: I felt like the front nine we did okay. My man was pretty solid on the back nine. Front nine we went to best ball, best ball from the tee shots, probably 3-under?

KIRK TRIPLETT: Yeah.

PAUL BROADHURST: I thought it was pretty good. After the position we're in, might be one or two beyond that end of the day, but it's a good effort.

KIRK TRIPLETT: That's what this tour is all about, 5-, 6-under a day, and on Sunday you've got a chance to get some momentum and win the tournament. It was tricky enough around here with the wind. You've got to not only hit the right shot, but you've got to hit it at the right time. I don't think there will be any real low scores around here.

PAUL BROADHURST: Wind swirls terribly around here. From the first play to the last play, it can go from downwind to into, and it caught us out a few times, didn't it?

KIRK TRIPLETT: Yeah.

PAUL BROADHURST: It's the same for everyone. Mountain Ridge was impossible in the Pro-Am, so actually I hope it's not quite as bad as that hopefully tomorrow. Look forward to it anyway.
