BERNHARD LANGER (-8)

Q. Bernhard, family obligations took you away from the Senior PGA a couple weeks ago for good reason.

BERNHARD LANGER: Very good reasons.

Q. That's okay. A wonderful round of golf today, eight birdies. What really clicked for you?

BERNHARD LANGER: Just very solid play, tee to green very solid, hit three or four really close, gimme range, the short game was pretty good. When I had to get up and down I got most of them up and down and just bogey free is always fun.

Q. Your game is rounding into shape with a win a couple weeks ago in Houston and we've got three more majors coming up on some pretty good golf courses. You must be excited for those?

BERNHARD LANGER: I am very much looking forward to the venues that we have this year, they're great golf courses. Hopefully my game will be in good shape when the majors come around, I would love to be in contention.

Q. Well, it looks like your game is rounding into shape. Anything that you worked on over the mini break that you had?

BERNHARD LANGER: Not really, I played very little golf. Just didn't have much time. When we were in Florida it rained a day or two, then flew to Germany, actually spent four and a half days in Germany and only played golf there one day. So it was mostly rest, but put a lot of work in the last couple days.
