Q. Wes, tell us what's working out here for you today.

WES SHORT, JR.: Actually, I hit it okay today, but putted really, really good. Made a lot of putts. Didn't really hit a whole lot of close ones, but they started going in pretty good.

Q. You're up there with the pack now. What's it going to take to continue moving forward in the next round?

WES SHORT, JR.: You've just got to keep it in the fairways around here and make some putts. I needed a good round today to try to get in contention, so I played pretty good today. So hopefully I don't play terrible, hopefully I don't get too far away.

Q. Good cap to the round, too.

WES SHORT, JR.: Yeah, nice birdie on the last hole, that helped. The only really bad swing I made was on 17 and made bogey there. It was nice to finish up the round with a nice birdie on 18.

Q. Doesn't seem like the rain delay hindered you very much out there?

WES SHORT, JR.: You know, kind of got lucky. I didn't ever have to get started and stopped, started and stopped. So when I got to the range this morning, they pretty much said "stop." It's better than having to start, stop all the time.

Q. Talk a little bit about the conditions this afternoon. Maybe it was a little bit of a break anyhow because it looked like it dried out pretty well by the time you finished.

WES SHORT, JR.: You know, they did a great job on this course getting it ready. They got a lot of rain the last week or so. There's some wet spots out there, but it's -- really, they've done a really good job.
