Q. What a finish. How much of a (inaudible) in that closing birdie after that bogey at 16 to get you to the top of the leaderboard?

BRIAN GAY: Yeah, it's nice to finish off with a birdie. I was on the wrong side of the green on 16, but it's always nice to end with a birdie.

Q. We've seen you on the front page of the leaderboard several times this season, five top-10s, you're chasing your fifth PGA TOUR title. What has it been about this season, sort of a rejuvenation process?

BRIAN GAY: It's just been kind of a long comeback. Out for a year and a half with two surgeries two years ago and taking longer than I thought to get back. (Inaudible)

Q. You're in position, as we just mentioned, for your fifth PGA TOUR title. I looked at the stats and surprisingly you're one of the best putters in the modern era not leading strokes gained. What is it about your game this week on this golf course that's gotten you to this point?

BRIAN GAY: A little bit of everything. (Inaudible.) Approach shots have been good. Got to get in the fairway to have a chance of getting close. Greens are so fast and slopey, if you get above the hole you're playing defense. Just got to get in the right spot.
