DAVID HEARN (-15)



Q. Last year you were kind of in the same position, you were tied for 64th and narrowly missed. What do you think that you learned from that experience last year to this weekend?

DAVID HEARN: Yeah, I don't know. I think that was a bit of a tough finish for me last year. I kept my card pretty handily for a long time all year, so it was kind of a weird spot to be in and again this spot this year. Like I said, I think I learned that I just really have to focus on myself and if I go out there and play a good game of golf this afternoon, it will take care of itself.

Q. You guys feel pressure a lot on the PGA TOUR. Maybe this is on a different level. You talk about staying calm and you look calm, but how do you keep yourself, especially once you're out there and sort of watching how things are going?

DAVID HEARN: Yeah, I'm trying not to focus too much on the outside stuff. Like I say, if I hit fairways and greens, and I've been doing a good job of that the first three rounds, I'm going to put up some good scores. That will be my mindset going into the last round here, just really stay in the moment, hit one shot, try to hit some fairways and greens.

Q. Lastly, you mentioned how well you've been hitting the ball, at the top of the list in strokes gained approach. How good have the irons been?

DAVID HEARN: They've been great this week. I feel like all summer long I've been just like so close to really playing the golf that I know I can play out here on a weekly basis. This week, just seems to be firing nicely for me. Not going to try to think about it too much, just going to try to keep hitting it at those pins and rolling in the putts.
