Q. Vijay, can you just take us through your round today, what was working?

VIJAY SINGH: Drove the ball pretty good, I don't think I missed too many fairways. If you drive the ball over here good, you're going to give yourself a lot of birdie opportunities. I putted well, too. I made some pretty nice birdie putts. If you drive it well and putt well, you're going to shoot a good number.

VIJAY SINGH: I played pretty solid all the way. I missed a couple of putts and made a couple of good ones. Didn't do too much wrong except for 13, I had a good chance. I hit a good drive there and a horrible second shot, made a bogey. Besides that, I'm pleased. The golf course is playing well. The greens are very receptive, so if you hit a good shot, you can get close.

Q. Is there something you want to focus on for tomorrow's round? I mean, if you drove it straight and you putted pretty well, just kind of do the same old, same old?

VIJAY SINGH: Kind of, same old, same old. See if I can hit it a little closer to the hole so I don't have to make 15-, 20-footers. You know, they tucked the pins in pretty good, so you've got to be very careful where if you miss it in the wrong place, you'll make a bogey.

Q. How was the crowd out there for you today?

VIJAY SINGH: Pretty good. One of the better crowds on the Champions Tour we've had all year besides the (inaudible.) But this is -- you know, brings back good memories.
