PATTON KIZZIRE: I don't know, I like it here. The beach, the hotels, the golf course, it all just kind of fits. You have to be comfortable to play well.

Q. How would you assess your round of 65 today?

I wasn't as comfortable as I was later in the round and as comfortable as I am here at the Mayakoba, but I settled in and I had a really, really nice stretch of birdie-eagle-eagle-birdie. That really got my round going and I played well after that. It was nice.

Q. How did the wind affect your round today?

PATTON KIZZIRE: Well, the wind here is normally the big factor. It wasn't blowing too hard today. It was a nice breeze and it was consistent. If we have a consistent wind, it makes it a little easier to judge your distance and judge your lines, so that was the story today.

Q. How would you describe your day?

PATTON KIZZIRE: It was a success. I started off a little shaky, I was trying a little too hard. Once I settled in, hit a few good shots and had a birdie-eagle-eagle-birdie stretch that really got me going and I flipped my round around and I played solid after that. It was all around a good day.

Q. Have you ever had a stretch like that where you were 6 under through four?

PATTON KIZZIRE: I was trying to think. I don't know, that's pretty extreme. Hopefully, I'll do it again soon.

Q. What was it like getting in that type of zone and really turning things around and then go from a guy who's struggling out of the gates to one who's (inaudible)?

PATTON KIZZIRE: Gosh, it's a good feeling. I have to hit a lot of good shots, but you have to get lucky, too. I holed out a wedge shot from the rough. I wasn't sure. It was a blind shot over some trees and I hit it and wasn't sure if it was on the right line or not, and next thing I know, they're cheering up by the green, so that was huge. But I played well all day, it was a good day.

Q. Did you think that was flying the green? You gave it the double "Oh, boy."

PATTON KIZZIRE: I thought it was to the right. To the right of the green is trouble and I couldn't see where I was going, and I hit it and it came out a little right of where I was aiming, so I was a little worried about it.
