Q. Danny, how would you assess that round?

DANNY LEE: Obviously it was a good round. Anything over 10 under par in two rounds is pretty good, but it's a very doable condition out there. I left a lot of birdie putts and a lot of easy up-and-downs out there and still able to shoot 5 under today. I'm pretty sure a lot of guys will pass me this afternoon, but I'm pretty happy with my result and I'm still in it.

Q. What would you expect for tomorrow? What would be your strategy?

DANNY LEE: There's no strategy, just keep hitting it and see how it turns out.

Q. Through half the tournament, 36 holes, only one bogey. It's a wonderful start.

DANNY LEE: Yeah, I'm pretty happy with my result, but I left myself a lot of birdie chances and a lot of easy up-and-downs out there. It was kind of a frustrating round for me, I could have done way better, but I guess that's golf. But I'm still very happy with my result.

Q. Are you comfortable in this position?

DANNY LEE: Yeah, I'm very comfortable.

Q. What is the key on this course, the tee, the green or everything?

DANNY LEE: Everything. You have to hit the fairways first. Off the tee it's very critical here because it's pretty generous fairway, but if you miss it, it looks like you're going to be in the water, so tee shot is very important.

Other than that, it's almost a good short iron shots and putting contest.
