WHEE KIM (-16)

Q. I thought it was a brilliant ball-striking round for you, you hit 11 of 14 fairways. Tell me about your confidence off the tee.

WHEE KIM: You know, I switched driver this week and I think it's been working really good. Hitting good and the swing was really comfortable all day.

Q. How big a change was it for you and was there a big learning curve?

WHEE KIM: Yeah, I think I'm doing good for short game around the green and bunker shot, chipping around the rough. It wasn't really easy lie, but I think I'm doing really good. Just, you know, that's working.

Q. What would be your thoughts playing in the final group on the final day?

WHEE KIM: You know, I've been in that -- in this position many times, but I think it's the time to get some trophy, you know, tomorrow. I'm ready for tomorrow and let's see what's going to happen.
