RICHY WERENSKI (-15)

Q. Everyone's trying to keep pace with Matt Kuchar, seems like he's trying to run away with things here at the Mayakoba Golf Classic. How would you characterize the 67 you turned in today?

RICHY WERENSKI: Pretty good today, I had a good day. You know, I started off a little shaky, made a couple bogeys early. Been doing a pretty good job of just staying patient out there and it's just kind of showed. I played a really good back nine, threw some birdies in there and stayed in decent position.

Q. Yeah, you had a slow start. What was the turning point in your round that led you to posting that 4-under 67?

RICHY WERENSKI: Yeah, the first birdie helped. Was that like seventh hole, par 5? Hit a great tee shot. Had to wait for a ruling or something going on up on the green, so I stood back in the fairway for a while, and then I proceeded to like chunk hook a 3-wood and actually got up and down from the rough. So made birdie there and then I birdied the next hole and just kind of got me going a little bit.
