

**NICK WATNEY ( -9)**

**Q. Nick Watney, what a beautiful round of golf today, 64 on the Plantation, 9 under par for the tournament. Tell me a little bit about your round and how excited you are to be in this position.**

**NICK WATNEY:** Well, the round was great. I started off with possibly the worst three-putt in the history of the tour, but got it back quickly and I'm very, very pleased with the day, but it was a fairly easy 64. I may have hit every green and didn't really have too much stress, so very excited. And I know we've got a long way to go, so going to keep executing.

**Q. Absolutely. And at the moment Charles Howell III has the lead at 14 under. You're certainly within striking distance. How good do you feel about your ball-striking and your putting heading into the Seaside this weekend?**

**NICK WATNEY:** I feel great. I'm very excited. Obviously Charles is playing very well, so I've just got to keep my head down and see where I end up. I couldn't really ask for much more at this point and I'm just excited to get after it.
