AUSTIN COOK (-14)

Q. Excellent play over the weekend, 65-64. I know that means a lot to you to make such a good defense of your title.

AUSTIN COOK: Yeah, definitely. I've got a baby coming in the middle of January and my next start may not be until Scottsdale, so I'll have a good two months off. To be able to make a little more extra cash here at the end of the year is nice.

Q. And it was a nice fall for you as well just in terms of a good start, FedExCup.

AUSTIN COOK: Yeah, definitely. Over in Malaysia had a T-13, not so great in Korea, but missed the cut in Vegas. To be able to come here and finish the calendar year off strong is nice.

Q. And it's really probably the second round this week that got you, otherwise you'd be looking at possibly back to back?

AUSTIN COOK: One hundred percent, yeah. The second round and the first 12 holes of the third round with the putting is what really got me. Then luckily some putts started to fall, and today ball-striking, I think my longest birdie putt that went in was four, five feet and I had six or seven of them today.
