WEBB SIMPSON (-18)

Q. So close that last putt, I really had a feeling you were going to make that one.

WEBB SIMPSON: Yeah, it's a bummer. We read it really well. It was just last two days on 18 I thought uncomfortable putts where it felt like it was going to break more than it did. Yesterday it did break more, today it didn't. It's unfortunate to end that way giving myself such a good chance, but hats off to Patrick and Charles, they played great golf today.
