BRADEN THORNBERRY (-6)

Q. Just talk to us about making the cut in your pro debut.

BRADEN THORNBERRY: Yeah, it's really exciting. Obviously it's kind of interesting looking at the leaderboard because the scores are so different on the courses. Even though that's not an easy golf course, I think I was in 74th out of the first round on the South, that was actually a pretty good spot to be, so I'm pretty happy with the way I'm playing. My driver was a little loose coming in, so I'm going to try to clean that up, but I like where I'm at going into the weekend.

Q. What was kind of the goal coming into this week?

BRADEN THORNBERRY: Just play as good as I can. I didn't set any goals like a top-10 or making the cut or anything like that, but kind of see what my game gave me and hopefully on Sunday I'll have a chance to make a little run.

Q. What's it been like out there with the pro debut? Does it feel any different at all?

BRADEN THORNBERRY: Not really, because I've played some as an amateur, so it's really the same thing, just this time I guess I can get a check at the end of the week. That's not really my concern right now. My concern is playing well and gaining status on certain tours. I like what I'm doing right now and feel good about it.

Q. What's the goal for the weekend?

BRADEN THORNBERRY: Kind of try to move up. It might be slow or it might be quick, but just try to steadily move my name up and see where it puts me on Sunday.

Q. What do the coming months look like for you?

BRADEN THORNBERRY: It will depend a little bit on how I play on my PGA starts versus how I play on my Web.com starts which route I kind of take. People have been asking me kind of about my schedule and it really depends. I'll be playing somewhere, I just don't know really where yet.
