

TIGER WOODS (-5)

Q. Tiger, does a finish like that help put a positive spin on an otherwise frustrating day?

TIGER WOODS: Yeah, you know, I finally drove it good and didn't hit my irons very close and again had a bunch of close calls on putts that just didn't go in. Then finally I made one -- I made the last two.

Q. What can you look for out of tomorrow's round in terms of trying to build towards Genesis, the rest of the season?

TIGER WOODS: Well, you know, just something positive. I think if I can get to double digits would be nice, just a nice way to end the week. I've got to play a little bit better than I have, and if I can drive it like I did today and hit my irons a little bit better and give myself plenty of looks, it's frustrating because I'm hitting a lot of good putts and they're just not going in.

Q. What do you know about Abraham Ancer? He'll probably play against you in the Presidents Cup.

TIGER WOODS: You know, I got a chance to watch him pretty closely this year or last year at my tournament in D.C. and I believe he shot 61 I believe or somewhere around there. Played an unbelievable round of golf there, had a chance to win. You know, Molinari put it on all of us on the last day. But he's got a lot of talent. He's been up on boards subsequently and it's just a matter of time before he really starts breaking through.

Q. Have you decided on (inaudible)?

TIGER WOODS: I have not decided yet.

Q. Tiger, in this first event back out after such a long break, what will be a nice reward for you tomorrow?

TIGER WOODS: As I said, if I can get to double digits, it would be nice. It's not too much to ask if I play well. If I drive it like this, hit my irons a little more crisp and make a few putts, I should be able to do that.

Q. Is the iron play that far off, Tiger? Just a small little tweak maybe?

TIGER WOODS: You know, I don't feel that bad over the shots, it's just that I'm -- through impact it's not as clean as I'd like. I warmed up really well, today was the best warm-up

session I've had all week. It doesn't mean I'm going to hit it well on the golf course. I just didn't quite have it with my iron game again, but I drove it so much better today, which was nice.

Q. Can you tell us where you're making the next stop?
