

JOEY GARBER (-9)

Q. So 7 under par today, what was working well for you?

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, you know, I got a couple good bounces and a couple bounces that didn't go my way the first couple days, so I ended up taking advantage of that, but things like that happen in good rounds. Just kept plugging along and hitting good golf shots and giving myself looks. I'm starting to feel more and more comfortable with the golf course and I think that's starting to pay off with my scores.

Q. Was the wind any different today than the first two days?

JOEY GARBER: It was a little less, I thought. Pretty much the same direction, a little bit different. Some of the holes played a little bit easier, some of them a little bit tougher. Yeah, it's been pretty similar every day, which makes it easy on us. We're kind of comfortable on the tee shots because we've hit them two or three times now in the same wind. Just staying committed to your targets and just firing at them.

Q. Is this one of those things where maybe momentum was on your side, make one birdie, make two, kind of get rolling?

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, for sure. I mean, I hit a bad shot off the tee on 4. I've done it twice this week and hit it in the right water, ended up making bogey there. Honestly, that was probably the momentum shift in the round, just making bogey there instead of double. Able to birdie the next and just kind of right the ship and keep going.

Q. You're a winner on the Web.com Tour. Now that you're close to the lead on the PGA TOUR, can you kind of draw on the experience from having a victory under your belt?

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, no doubt. I've had some wins around in junior golf and college golf and it's no different. It's obviously a little bit more pressure out here, but I'm comfortable. I mean, I know these guys and I'm fortunate enough to live in St. Simons and play with them every day. I believe my game's good enough and hopefully tomorrow will be proof of that.

Q. Looking forward to a good opportunity tomorrow?

JOEY GARBER: I am, yeah. There's nothing better than playing late on Sunday on the PGA TOUR. I'm very fortunate to be in the position I'm in and look forward to getting that competitive juice going tomorrow.
