**Q. Tied the low score of the week. Did you feel a round like this coming on?**

**SHAWN STEFANI:** You know, I can't really say I felt it coming on, but I was playing good kind of coming into today. I felt like I just needed to put it all together. And today I really didn't hit it my best starting out, but I just kind of stayed patient and I made some good putts that kind of kept some momentum going and I just kind of fed off that.

Then, as the round kind of progressed, I was able to knock in some really nice putts, which in return kind of gives you some confidence. So on the back nine I was like, you know what, let's go get it. We have nothing to lose, let's go get it, let's keep making birdies. Was able to roll in a couple nice putts for birdie, one off the green, one from 25, 30 feet.

**I said, hey, things are going my way. So I just said, keep the hammer down and try to keep pushing, so it was nice. I feel like I've been -- I can't say I felt this round coming on, but I have felt like I've been playing better than I have been playing. So it does surprise me a little bit that it happened today on Sunday, but at the same time I'm happy that it did.**

**Q. Yeah, and these tournaments like Puerto Rico and Sanderson Farms, they used to be known as those other events, but they're obviously incredibly significant. How much does an event like this mean to you? Obviously you're going to rack up a lot of FedExCup points.**

**SHAWN STEFANI:** That's really the most important thing is the points. I'm sitting 170 in FedEx right now, so I need as many points as I can get. I was like, you know what, who cares about the money, who cares about the finish. I mean, finishing outside the top-10 here really does you no good, so try to keep making birdies and try to finish as high as you can, because right now I need as many points as I can get. It was actually, it was nice to know that I finished off a good round and say, okay, look, now we're going to be able to make some significant amount of points because obviously this is a FedExCup event.
