Q. Did you have a number in mind today that you were going for?

It's probably going to cost us the tournament. But that's golf, right? We battled through a hard stretch yesterday. I thought I handled it well. And then came back, closed out the round nicely yesterday for even par and put ourselves in a position to have a good day today.

Q. Finishing as strong as you did today, what does that do for your confidence going into next week?

ROGER SLOAN: Again, I'm just working on the things that I mentioned earlier, and I'm just happy that I was able to execute some shots out there coming down the stretch. And I'm looking forward to next week. I haven't played the Honda. I'm really looking forward to playing there, PGA National. So, we're just going to keep on doing what we do.
