

SEPP STRAKA

Q. Talk to me a little bit about your season so far. Has there been some adjustments, and just kind of getting to know new places, new golf courses, that sort of thing? Have you started to feel a little bit more comfortable now?

SEPP STRAKA: Yeah, definitely feel more comfortable. It's definitely an adjustment. The golf courses are a little harder on the PGA Tour. And you shoot 1 under in nine holes, you're not losing 40 spots like do you on the Web. So, that part's kind of nice. And adjustment, the Web prepares you really well for what's to come on the PGA Tour.

I feel like my game has been pretty good for a couple weeks. I had a terrible week of scoring at Pebble, but I felt like my game was pretty good, ever since Torrey, really. I played well out there. And ever since then, I have hit the ball pretty nice.

Q. How about today, what was kind of the difference? You made some putts obviously, a great score to come out of Thursday with.

SEPP STRAKA: Yeah, putted really well. Putted well. My irons were really the key today. It was really windy out there, so I put the irons in the right spots, gave myself a lot of close looks. I hit it inside of three feet a couple times from outside of 100, so that's always nice. So, yeah, the irons were definitely the key, I feel like today.

Q. What was your first impression of this golf course?

SEPP STRAKA: It's great, it's really good. Perfect shape. Absolutely immaculate. No divots. The greens are just absolutely pure. It really is a nice track.

Q. Pretty much the same game plan for tomorrow?

SEPP STRAKA: Yeah, just keep trucking, keep pushing that rock up the hill. Pretty much do that every round this week, yeah.

Q. If you had a shot of the day, what would it be?

SEPP STRAKA: Shot of the day today. That's hard. Let me think. The one on -- what was that par? Par 3 -- well, par 4, actually, No. 3. I hit it -- I was in the middle of the fairway and hit it from probably about 138, I think, hit it to two feet for birdie, so that was definitely the shot of the day right there, yeah.
