BILLY ANDRADE (-12)

Q. You're two back from the lead right now. What do you think you need to do tomorrow to change that?

BILLY ANDRADE: Well, I'm in a good position. And I didn't make a lot of birdies today, I made three. I had a lot of chances and I just got to give myself chances tomorrow, see if I can get a little hotter with the putter, and if I can, I have a good chance.

Q. Tomorrow's weather's a little iffy. Does that concern you? Does that change your prep at all?

BILLY ANDRADE: Not really. This has been -- we've been iffy every day, you know, this tournament, so I assume we're going to play early and try to get it in. But no, you've just got to get up tomorrow and be ready to go.

Q. This course is a little difficult. Got to get birdies to win this?

BILLY ANDRADE: Yeah. You know, if you're driving it good and you're keeping it in play, you're going to have a chance to -- your preferred lie, so it's really important to hit fairways here. If you do that, you're ahead of the eight ball. And I assume tomorrow's going to be the same thing.

Q. Are you feeling good about tomorrow?
