KEVIN SUTHERLAND (-17)

Q. (In progress) eight back of the lead. What was the mentality beginning Sunday?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: You know, I wasn't -- I knew I needed to shoot something really good. I wasn't really thinking anything about what the leaders were doing. In fact, I didn't even think about the lead until I was making the turn. But I played really well the day before and I just was hoping just to extend that momentum I had. I just kind of got hot on the back and I hit some really good putts on the back nine, because I hit a lot of good shots, but I had to make a lot of 10-footers and stuff and they were just all going in today, which is good.

Q. Well, out in 32 and then a run of six straight birdies. You've shot 59 before on this tour. Was the mentality the same coming down the stretch trying to shoot 59 and also win a golf tournament?

KEVIN SUTHERLAND: I think a little bit. You try to make as many birdies as you can. Sometimes when you get rolling like that you get hungry, the birdies seem easy, and that's the way it was on the back side. I was hitting a lot of good shots and rolling the ball well, so it's the same kind of mentality. When you're shooting 59, you're like -- I was really excited to get to the next tee because I thought I was going to make another birdie and that's kind of what it was today.

Q. Well, congratulations on the course record, 62. You're right now tied, so potential playoff. Well done today.
