**Q. Ryan, despite the bogey at the end, still in good position heading to the weekend.**

I hit it in the trees, hit it in the trees again, but I had a perfect number with a wedge, hit it up there like three feet. Sometimes you get those breaks, took advantage of it. But like I said, we're going to have to make some birdies this weekend and I've got to go get some work in.

**Q. (Question about morning versus afternoon conditions.)**

**RYAN ARMOUR:** You know, I don't know. Yesterday I felt it played a little easier actually in the afternoon. It was not as windy, and to me wind is the great equalizer for pro golf. We've got to figure out where it's coming from and where we want to land it and control our trajectory. So with it gusting a little bit more today, I think it will play a little bit tougher.
