Q. Joey, if we can get some comments on your day, please.

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, got off to a little bit of a slow start, but started to get comfortable on the back nine, made some putts and finished really strong. Looking forward to tomorrow.

Q. You made some good moves on moving day.

JOEY GARBER: Yeah. You know, I would have liked to turn a little better, but finished well on the back nine. Serves me well going into tomorrow. Get some work done this afternoon and see if we can't post a really low one tomorrow.

Q. As the weekend's moved on, have more people kind of been yelling your name and have you noticed more support?

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, it's been so cool for me to be home in Michigan and to have friends and family around. There's been a lot of Go Joeys, so it's been cool, and I look forward to being with them again tomorrow.

Q. You said you putted pretty poorly yesterday. Totally different today?

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, totally different today. Did some work last night with my caddie on the greens until about 8:00 last night. Sometimes you got to just put in a little extra work and got comfortable today and it paid off.

Q. Was it a major change at all or just something tiny?

JOEY GARBER: No, just a little forward press. My hands were getting a little too far behind the ball, kind of throwing at it a little bit. So just kind of leading through it and making sure I follow through basically.

Q. Any changes do you think you need to make for tomorrow?

JOEY GARBER: No, just keep doing what I'm doing. Maybe figure out a few things off the tee on the front nine to give myself more opportunities, but I feel really comfortable on the back nine. I think I can get those par 5s, I've got enough length to get to both of them. Hopefully I'll throw in a few eagles.

Q. Were the greens softer at all today with the rain?

JOEY GARBER: Yeah, always in the morning they're going to be a little softer. So the front nine, we had to deal with that a little bit, but they were perfect once we got to the back nine, absolutely perfect. They're going to have good scoring conditions this afternoon, so I'm going to need a low one tomorrow.
