

BRANDT SNEDEKER (-17)

Q. Brandt, if we could just get an opening comment on your performance here this week in Detroit.

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Yeah, you know, it was a great week. I was kind of blown away for a first-time event with the fans and the outpouring of support we felt as the players this week. It was really cool to feel that. I haven't felt that in a long time out here, to see so many people grateful for us coming up here and playing golf.

So I think Quicken Loans did a great job, Rocket Mortgage did an awesome job of putting on an event and getting the city behind us. It was a lot of fun to play in front of them. Kind of fed off them the last two days. I played really good on the weekend, didn't make a bogey, did a lot of good stuff. Hoping we can build on this going into The Open.

Q. Crazy to think that 17 under isn't the winning score?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: I knew it was going to be low. I mean, obviously Nate's playing unbelievable, so you're going to have weeks like that where guys just get going.

I'll look back on Thursday where I think I made seven birdies and shot 2 under par. I mean, if I don't make those dumb mistakes on Thursday, I'm kind of up there near 23 with a chance. So you look back on the course of the week, it's not just what you do on the weekends, it's how you do on Thursday morning, too. Some stuff to build on, some stuff to kind of clean up before I get going.

Q. Talking about the event, what really stuck out to you?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: I couldn't believe the amount of support. Normally these things take a few years to really get their stronghold going, but I've been thanked by more fans this week for coming to play golf, which just blew me away. You know, it's like this is what I do and I love being up here.

And then just to see the outpouring of support for this event from the community, not only from Quicken Loans and what they do for the city of Detroit, but just for the community and the fans, just unbelievable. I haven't seen anything like this on Tour for a long time.

Q. Is this tournament on the short list for you next year to come back?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Obviously when you have a good finish like I did and I love the golf course and obviously the fans being what they were, yeah, I'll definitely make sure I put this

one in next year, make sure I come back up.

Q. Assuming you're going to the British, what's going well for your game right now and what might you need to work on?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Just got to kind of tighten up my ball-striking a little bit. My short game was unbelievable this week. I was up there for top three or four putting for the week. Just kind of got to get my ball-striking where I can kind of take advantage of that short game. A few loose shots here on Thursday and Friday kind of killed me, and then on the weekend I played pretty good.

Q. How much do you guys talk about what events you do? The schedule is what it is and not everybody makes everything. How much do you kind of pioneer for this?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: There'll be a lot of guys asking. We always ask on first-year events the guys who played, what did you think, how's the golf course, what's the setup like, was it fun. They're going to get a lot of positive reviews from this week.

The course is a lot of fun to play. Make a lot of birdies if you're playing good. If you're not playing good, you're going to struggle a little bit. But then, you know, the support and the way they run the event. We all stayed in downtown, had a great time. Unbelievable how much downtown's changed since the last time I was here. So there will be a lot of positive things from this week.
