STEVE STRICKER (-1)

Q. Obviously not the day you wanted. Just reflections on the week?

STEVE STRICKER: Yeah, we got off to a good start today. Just made too many mistakes again. Didn't make too many putts when I did have some opportunities, and you've got to have all parts of your game working here. It's a great course. It was set up tough, but a great week. You know, I mean to get back in the mix of it again, it was fun. And I didn't play that well really after the first day. It was a grind.

Q. Right. What was it, do you think?

STEVE STRICKER: It was a little bit of everything. I didn't drive it that well like the second and third rounds, and then didn't really hit very good irons at times. Just a little bit of everything. But I hung in there. I was grinding and trying to claw and scratch my way in, but it wasn't meant to be.

Q. Kind of jumbled up there a lot throughout the day. Do you watch the leaderboards a bit?

STEVE STRICKER: Yeah, yeah. Knew exactly where I was and what I needed to do really. I had a really good look at birdie on nine and 10 and 11 and don't make any of them, where if I could have got some of those to go, maybe some momentum would have got on my side. But just never could get any putts to go or any momentum going.

Q. Are you surprised, especially after the performance at Regions and Senior Open and the 64 on Thursday, to kind of stall out a little bit?

STEVE STRICKER: Yeah, it is disappointing, but I'm tired, too. I've played a lot of golf for me. This is like 16 for me, I think, in a shorter period of time, too. I'm a little worn out, but no excuse. Yeah, after the first round here I just had intentions to keep going and just keep putting the pedal down and I just couldn't do it.

Q. I know right now you just want to go shut it down for a little bit. What are your plans? Back to the PGA TOUR for Wyndham, I assume?

STEVE STRICKER: Yeah, I think I'm going to go play Wyndham. So got a couple weeks off, go play Wyndham and then see how that goes.
