

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW
July 19, 2019



D.J. TRAHAN (-12)

Q. D.J., can I get some comments on your play today?

D.J. TRAHAN: I had another great day. I struck the ball well yesterday and did the same today. Unfortunately, I missed two greens today and made bogeys on both those holes, but just a matter of missing a couple putts. But I hit the ball well again today and did everything -- executed my game plan exactly like I needed to. I still feel like maybe I left a couple out there and the course is very gettable, and 5 under is still a great round.

Q. What's the key in conditions like this, just hot and humid conditions?

D.J. TRAHAN: It's just hard. I mean, obviously you've got to hydrate and just try and stay in the shade as much as possible. The guys this afternoon are obviously going to get it worse than we did, but it was still very warm this morning. It's just you've got to be patient. It's no different than playing in wind or rain or cold. The elements definitely have their effect on you and you've just got to try and work through it and battle through it.

Q. In terms of the course conditions itself, it was a little soft yesterday a lot of guys were saying. A little firmer today, I take it. Did that change anything at all for you?

D.J. TRAHAN: It did and it didn't. I think the greens are still pretty receptive. They firmed up maybe a little bit, but the fairways are maybe getting a little more bounce. Maybe on some shots where you might have some issues with run-through the fairway, you'll have to start paying attention to stuff like that if we stay dry the rest of the week. The golf course really didn't firm up too terribly much. It is a bit firm, though.

Q. Heading into the weekend, you're in great shape.

D.J. TRAHAN: I'm excited obviously, yeah. I'm in position. We'll see what the guys do this afternoon. Obviously there was a lot of low scores yesterday, but I should be within striking distance for the weekend and I'm looking forward to it. I'm hitting the ball well and my mind's in a good place. It's just a matter of going out and executing at this point is really what it feels like for me.
