

ROUND 4 INTERVIEW

KELLY KRAFT (-25)

Q. Obviously not the finish you wanted, tough there on the back. Can you just walk us through kind of your back nine there?

KELLY KRAFT: I just didn't have my best stuff today, but I had it going there; made a couple birdies, 14, 15 I think. I just gave it to him coming down the stretch, that's basically all there is to it.

Q. Sort of evolved into match play pretty quickly out there?

KELLY KRAFT: Yeah, it did. We were kind of two, three ahead all day long. But I made some good swings kind of early on the back nine and just hit one left on the par 3, made a bogey there, but I hit a perfect golf shot on 17 and the wind just died. I mean, it was straight downwind and when I hit it, just caught a gust. If that ball lands two yards further, it's right next to the hole. So a little unfortunate there, but that's golf.

Q. Hard to get momentum today anyway, looked like both you guys --

KELLY KRAFT: I mean, we had like a three-hour rain delay, so that kind of, you know, that kind of kills any momentum. It's not like we had that much early in the round to begin with, though.

Q. What did you do during the rain delay?

KELLY KRAFT: Yeah, just ate, sat around. Just kind of hung out and waited to hear what was going to happen.

Q. Even though it's not the result you wanted, you still moved into the top 125, so I guess that's a positive thing to take with you?

KELLY KRAFT: Yeah, I guess. I mean, I would have liked to win, but, you know, got to play better than that coming down the stretch.
