**Q. Making a lot of pars, and then what a great finish. Great run down the stretch, made a bunch of birdies. Your thoughts on the day?**

**PAUL CASEY:** I needed Jordan to putt for me, didn't I? He might have shot 57 or something. I hit it really, really well. Yeah, proximity to the hole has been strong, I hit a lot of greens in regulation. Really happy with how I played. And I love this golf course. It kind of -- I like it, it gets my ball-striking kind of going. But I'm glad I made those because the scoring is so good this week, everybody's playing really good golf, so I needed to make those coming in to keep myself in it.

**Q. And I know you said this week you're kind of freewheeling it because of where you are in the FedExCup standings and the Wyndham Rewards, but you had to show a lot of patience out there today because we see all those red numbers going up and you're making pars, eventually you caught up to it?**

**PAUL CASEY:** Correct. So I think the key, Jordan even mentioned it, the big putt was my par putt on 8. Like I chunked the wedge and then messed up the chip, so it was a big putt. Make that one and kept the round going. If I don't, then it's tricky.

So, I mean, I sound freewheeling and I am, I'm very kind of in a position where I can only improve my position in the FedExCup and maybe grab a bigger Wyndham Rewards than I already kind of got. It's not locked up, there's still guys that can pass me. But yeah, I want to move up, plain and simple. So yes, I'm freewheeling, but there's always a little bit of pressure.
