Q. Excellent start. If we can get some comments on the round?

MATTHEW WOLFF: Yeah, today was -- it was a long day. It was really hot out there, so I just tried to stay cool and stuff, but I got off to a good start. Hit a nice pitching wedge on the first hole to start off my day and kind of hung in there and was pretty steady all day. Hit one errant drive on 11 that I hit OB, but I battled back from that right away. Barely missed one on 12, but then going back on 13, and then that eagle on 15 kind of closed my round on a high note. I think I had a good number, and I couldn't see where I was hitting it, but me and Steve picked out a good kind of spot, and to be able to knock one in close there and get eagle is, like I said, nice finish and gives me a lot of confidence going into tomorrow.

Q. Has your approach changed for this week in terms of position in the Playoffs? Are you approaching this any differently than you think you might have if you were trying to play for your card?

I don't really think about any of the FedExCup points or the world ranking points or where I'm at in relation to everyone else, all I can do is play my best golf and control what I'm in control of.
