

RYAN ARMOUR (-10)

Q. Ryan, after day two, 10 under. Just a few comments on the first couple days.

RYAN ARMOUR: Yesterday was an real easy round of golf, hit a lot of fairways, a lot of greens. Today, not so much. Today was a lot of scrambling. Then kind of made an eagle coming in on 15 and birdie on 16. It was a struggle today. Ball was not flying as far as it was yesterday and obviously wasn't running out with the amount of rain we had. But all in all, pretty pleased.

Q. In spite of struggling, like you said, and grinding, you still had a really good round. So just talk a little bit about that.

RYAN ARMOUR: Absolutely, I'm ecstatic the position I'm in, as long as Snedeker, Webb or someone doesn't go out and run away with this this afternoon. It was tough today to figure out how far -- the ball was not traveling in the air or on the ground very far, so it took a while to adjust.

Q. Did you have to figure that out mid round?

RYAN ARMOUR: Oh, yeah, as we were going, definitely. It just wasn't -- ball wasn't carrying. It's heavy air right now and moisture's even coming off the ground, so the ball just wasn't going very far.

Q. Ryan, how do you think the rain affected the greens?

RYAN ARMOUR: The greens are perfect. I get excited when I come to certain events and this is one of them with how good the greens are. The greens staff does such a phenomenal job here at Sedgefield, so I always look forward coming to Wyndham.

Q. Obviously you've got to be happy going into tomorrow, especially after learning what you figured out today?

RYAN ARMOUR: Yeah, I felt like the way I hit it on the front or the first 12, 13 holes wasn't very good, and I kind of maneuvered my way around enough to where I didn't fall backwards, and then all of a sudden, you know, like I said, make eagle on 15 and then birdie 16 and all of a sudden you shoot 10 spots up the leaderboard, so it was good.
