

SUNGJAE IM (-11)

Q. Three-under 67 today after 62 yesterday. Just a few comments about the round today.

SUNGJAE IM: Yeah, I was off to a really good start making four straight birdies on the front, so I had great expectations and thought it was going to be a great day. But making two bogeys on No. 10 and 11 kind of stopped my momentum and kind of stopped my play a little bit, but I'm overall pretty happy with my round.

Q. How about the wet conditions, did that change your game at all?

SUNGJAE IM: Yeah, with a lot of rain from yesterday, the fairways were very wet and I noticed the whole course is playing very wet, so I have to be very careful and very precise of my yardages. Especially with my approach shots from the fairway, I had a little bit more of extra thought to my yardages and I feel like that helped me today.

Q. Have you thought any about the Wyndham Rewards? With a win you could get inside the Top-10 of the Wyndham Rewards, which is obviously nice bonus money.

SUNGJAE IM: Yeah, currently I'm in good position regarding the Wyndham Rewards Top-10. It looks like a win will get me into the Top-10, and obviously I don't know what's going to happen in the third round or fourth round, but it's definitely motivating me to have me land inside the Top-10 for that bonus money.

Q. You were playing with Mike Weir today, who is a Presidents Cup assistant captain. What are your thoughts on the possibility of playing for Ernie Els and Mike Weir at the Presidents Cup?

SUNGJAE IM: Yeah, the Presidents Cup in Incheon 2015 really motivated me to hopefully make the team this year, and even though it's not confirmed yet, I feel like I have a great chance to make the team and it's something that I'm really striving for. It's been a goal ever since the 2015 Presidents Cup, so I'm really looking forward to what happens.

Q. Sungjae, you played in so many more events than the other top guys. Do you ever get tired?

SUNGJAE IM: Yeah, playing as a rookie this year, I wanted to play as many tournaments as I can, and I honestly feel I can play a lot better when I play more tournaments. I feel like it gives me an advantage for next year, because I don't know a lot of these courses, to play as much as possible, get to know these courses and be prepared for next year, so I honestly

think of it as an advantage.

Q. Your first tournament this year, Safeway Open, one shot from the playoff. Have you thought about how you might have sort of a bookend this year where you finished one shot better with an actual win?

SUNGJAE IM: I feel like I had a lot of opportunities this year for a win and I was in contention a lot and I'll definitely use those experiences to help me this week. I definitely will use those experiences to not make the same mistakes this week and hopefully put all my focus into getting a win.

Q. Do you have any memories from Si Woo Kim winning here a couple years ago?

SUNGJAE IM: Yeah, I definitely did watch Si Woo win this tournament. I watched it on TV, I wasn't able to play obviously, but it definitely will serve as a motivator to help me this week.
