

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW
August 2, 2019



ADAM SVENSSON (-11)

ADAM SVENSSON: (in progress) I'd say in the 14th fairway I actually (inaudible) a par 70 and it was. Got a little nervous, but I was happy with the way I played. I had a couple missed putts coming down the stretch.

Q. When was the last time you broke 60?

ADAM SVENSSON: Broke 60?

Q. Yeah, have you done it? I mean, not in a PGA TOUR round, but maybe just at home?

ADAM SVENSSON: No, never done it.

Q. Being tied for the lead, I mean, nobody projects they're going to go out there and do something like that no matter how confident they are. Where do you sit going into tonight just kind of mentally?

ADAM SVENSSON: Just same routine, just going to go hit a couple balls, maybe putt a little bit. I'm not going to put any more practice in. Just have a good dinner and have a good sleep.

Q. How do you sleep with the lead?

ADAM SVENSSON: I don't know, just pass out.

Q. When in this round did you realize you were having a really good round, you might have a chance to get 59? At what point in this round did you feel like you were really in a good groove?

ADAM SVENSSON: Like I said, 13. I was 7 under through 10, nine holes, whatever it was. Yeah, 13 where I was kind of like, all right, I'm 9 under par and there's still four or five holes and a par 5. Yeah, I was actually pretty calm. I thought I would be a little more nervous than I was.

Q. Are you comfortable with the way that you finished off the back nine when you were --

ADAM SVENSSON: Yeah, the missed putt on the par 5 was pretty disappointing, but coming down the stretch, two tough shots at 18 there. I mean, that pin location is really

hard. So just happy to par 18 and look forward to tomorrow.

Q. What has Danny done for you on the bag? You guys are somewhat newish together.

ADAM SVENSSON: Well, Danny caddies for BJ, he's just here helping me out a couple weeks. You know, he just keeps me calm. I play with him back home and he knows a lot of my numbers and stuff like that. We joked around out there, it was fun.

Q. (No microphone.)

ADAM SVENSSON: Yeah, we play, kind of play all over.

Q. When you see that leaderboard all knotted up at the top, normally if you shoot 9 under you're great, but when you see it all knotted up, what's your strategy going into tomorrow?

ADAM SVENSSON: Same game plan. You know, we play aggressive at some flags and we shoot wedges from other ones. I think I learned a lot from the Sony Open, shooting 61 as well. I just played too aggressive trying to get out front and tomorrow I'm just going to play my normal game.

Q. Is this your first tournament with the claw?

ADAM SVENSSON: I've used it in the past, but I haven't used it for about two years now. The claw is a bigger grip and (inaudible) style putting.

Q. (Question about FedExCup standings.)

ADAM SVENSSON: Yeah. Obviously I came into this week, I was talking to Danny, my caddie, who said, "You know what? Go out and just no pressure, just go out there and play and see what we can do."
