

JOHNSON WAGNER (-7)

Q. Johnson, 7-under 63, excellent start. Get some comments on your round.

JOHNSON WAGNER: Yeah, it was really good. It was a little off early, but hit some beautiful iron shots, got into a good feel with my ball-striking and really hit the ball solid today, made some putts. It was, you know, exactly how you imagine it going.

Q. And I know you're not one to think ahead just after round one, but currently projected inside the Top 125. What's the key in terms of not thinking about that?

JOHNSON WAGNER: Well, I know that I need, I think, at worst a two-way fourth or something. So I know right where I need to finish this week. I came out with the mindset to play fearless and not worry about it and try to go win a golf tournament. I mean, there's no need to be nervous because I have to basically contend Sunday, so I'm here to put myself in position and have a chance Sunday.

Q. Didn't get the heavy rains we thought we may get late in the day, so ball in hand. Just talk a little bit about the conditions and playing that way today.

JOHNSON WAGNER: I mean, it had to rain four inches in an hour at my hotel last night just a couple miles away and it didn't seem like there was a drop of rain on the golf course yesterday. So it was nice ball in hand, it's always nice. But I couldn't believe -- we heard rumbling of thunder from seven on today and didn't get blown off. I would have bet money we wouldn't have finished our round today, but happy to get it finished and get some sleep.
