Q. Ben, under the circumstance, you're trying to run down your first win on the PGA TOUR. How did you feel about that round today of 66?

BYEONG HUN AN: Oh, it was steady, bogey free again. That's what I was trying to do today. And then a couple birdies here and there, that helped. Sixty-six is a decent score here when you have the lead. Still, I'm only one ahead of everyone, so I just need to keep my head straight and try to play my best golf tomorrow.

Q. How about the occurrences at 14 and 15? Fourteen you roll in the 51-footer and somehow you make a five and save your par at 15 after a poor drive.

BYEONG HUN AN: Yeah, 14, it's been a weird hole. The first day I chipped it in and yesterday I holed like a 70-footer and today I holed another 50-footer, so it's been a really weird hole. I'll take it.

But 15, that was probably the time that I almost made a bogey, but I hit a great bunker shot out of there and my goal was just trying to get something around the green that was playable and somehow made a five. That definitely helped. It would have been nice if I had made birdie the following hole, but definitely I'll take five from where my tee shot ended up.

Q. All right. So you go to Sunday now. How are you feeling about the game, the plan of attack, everything that's involved in a Sunday on the PGA TOUR?

BYEONG HUN AN: The game's I feel like still there. I hit some good shots today. You know, not as good as the first round, but it's still I'm quite happy with where I am and I'm holing a lot of putts. Still making a lot of long putts. We'll see what happens tomorrow. You know, I could have another day like the first day, I could hit it really good and then make putts, so we'll see. But I definitely need to play my best golf to win, that's for sure.

Q. Ben, if we can get some comments on your round today.

BYEONG HUN AN: It was similar to yesterday, to be fair. I had some missed shots here and there, but I scrambled well today. Another bogey free. I'm quite happy with it. Sixty-six out here when you have the lead, that's pretty good.

Q. To take a one-shot lead, that has to just do wonders confidence-wise for you.

BYEONG HUN AN: One shot is basically nothing. Like today, Brice made birdie at the first and I made a par and that's one shot right there. So it's not big of a lead, it's just one shot.

But playing in the final group, that's what I've been wanting to do my career, and then hopefully I can pull it out tomorrow and play my best golf tomorrow so I can win it.

Q. Any different mindset tomorrow?

BYEONG HUN AN: Yeah, just keep my head up and my confidence pretty high. I've been hitting it pretty good, so need to not make any silly mistakes. That's what I'm trying to do. If it's meant to be, then I'll shoot low scores. If not, I might not have a good day. But definitely my confidence is there, so I'll probably have no problem sleeping.
