

**RYAN ARMOUR ( -15)**

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**Q. Ryan, I want to call these rounds in the mid 60s sort of ho-hum stuff, just solid golf the last few days?**

**RYAN ARMOUR:** Yeah. I wish I would have got off to a little better start today, but I just told my caddie, Jim, that we need to be patient, there's birdies out there, we just had to execute and hit some good shots.

**Q. You were 117th entering the week in FedExCup points. You weren't in any danger probably of falling out of that, but now in a position to really give yourself a really big boost going into the Playoffs?**

**RYAN ARMOUR:** Yeah, that was the idea. I took last week off to get rested, trying to make a push. You know, everyone wants to get to Atlanta for the TOUR Championship, but in the position I'm in, if I got to BMW and see what happens there.

**Q. These wet conditions, now the ball being back down, you hit a lot of fairways. How much is that helping you out here this week?**

**RYAN ARMOUR:** This golf course is always about hitting fairways. I think if you hit fairways, you can get to some of the hole locations. But out of the rough, especially ball's starting to knuckle a little bit, it's getting a little drier up top, so you're catching some flyers.

**Q. Best thing from today you carry into tomorrow?**

**RYAN ARMOUR:** Pace of the putts was really, really good. I didn't have very many come-backers, which is good around here to have that tap-in speed. And then also to know that I was patient at the beginning of the round and stuff did come to me.

**Q. Ryan, if we can get some comments on your play.**

**RYAN ARMOUR:** Kind of a not very good start, bogeyed the second hole, missed a four-footer there. Nothing really going. Didn't birdie five, the par-5, and then Paul and I both hit it close on six and made it and we kind of just fed off each other from there. Birdieing six, seven, eight was a big jump. Then I made something on 10 that you're not supposed to make, a little roller coaster putt from behind the hole. Then able to birdie 15 coming in, and then the up-and-down on 16 was ridiculous. Would have liked to have gotten one more coming in, but I just didn't get it close enough.

**Q. Are you happy with the overall round? You've got to be pretty happy where you're**

at?

**RYAN ARMOUR:** Absolutely. Anytime you can shoot three rounds in the mid 60s on the PGA TOUR and here at Sedgefield, yeah, you're going to be happy.
