

JASON KOKRAK (-12)

Q. Jason, you're cruising along, pars on the first four and then the fifth, my goodness, knock it inside three feet. That eagle got you going. Six under today, tell us about the round.

JASON KOKRAK: Really, ball-striking was key. I hit it very well off the tee. Hit some quality shots, didn't really -- hit a good putt on one, two. Three was a tough putt. Missed opportunities there, but hit a great 8-iron into the par 5 and hit some good shots all day. I gave myself a lot of looks and made a few, so it was a nice round.

Q. How good was that up-and-down you made at 18? I mean, that putt you had from back of the green, that was a roller coaster, right?

JASON KOKRAK: It was. If that putt jumps over that into-the-grain spot, I'm going to be chipping from the front edge of the green somewhere down there, and if it comes off a little bit slow, I've got the same putt down the slope. So I was kind of blessed to get the ball rolling and it came down the slope and gave myself about a four- or five-footer for par.

Q. You're having a great year. You came into this event 45th in the FedExCup point standings and now you're trending into the 30s, I think maybe 40 right now, but this is going to be an interesting leaderboard to watch tomorrow. What's the key to your success this season? What's been going so well?

JASON KOKRAK: I started working with Drew Steckel about two years ago. Just the consistency of the iron game has been way better, the misses aren't there. I started working with Josh Gregory last year at Greenbrier and my short game's got a hell of a lot better. More consistent putting. A couple events here and there kind of went the other way, but overall, trending in the right direction.

So overall the last two years have been trending more consistent, so I guess I'll chalk it up to working with those guys. You know, they're good for me and good for my game. I hired David Robinson two years ago and he's a great green reader, so I owe him a lot of credit. It takes a lot of pressure off of me and I know he's a great green reader and we trust each other and we go with it.
