Q. J.T., if we can get some comments on your round today.

J.T. POSTON: Yeah, it was solid. It's been pretty good ball-striking the last three days and today was kind of the same but not quite as sharp, but good enough to still get it around in 4 under. Made a couple nice par saves on the back nine to kind of keep the round going.

Q. What's it going to take tomorrow?

J.T. POSTON: I would say probably 20 at least. I'm going to say at least 20, maybe a few more than that. I would imagine 17, maybe 18 could be leading by the end of the day. The course is still soft, greens are really pure. Guys are going to be able to get close to the pin and make some putts.

Q. You're a local guy, what does it mean for you to be in contention?

J.T. POSTON: We have quite the crew out here, some Hickory people, some Western Carolina people. It's fun. It's fun to play in front of a home crowd and some friends and family, a lot of familiar faces. Yeah, hopefully try and keep it going and have a chance tomorrow and it will be a lot of fun.

Q. What was working for you on the front nine?

J.T. POSTON: The same thing as the last two days. Ball-striking's been really good, haven't missed many greens. Just keep giving myself a lot of looks and hit a lot of good putts. Made a few, but just really steady, solid golf for the most part.
