**Q. Brandt, 2 under today, you get it to minus 8. A few birdies out there, one bogey. Your thoughts on how it went?**

**BRANDT SNEDEKER:** Yeah, kind of sums up my week right now, pretty frustrating. When I do hit some good shots, it seems like I've got really, really tough putts downhill, hard to make. And a few loose ones I'm not taking care of saving pars or making pars from them. So nice to see a few putts go in. I made some putts on first day and the last two days I made absolutely zero, and it's frustrating because the greens are perfect, just over-read them a little bit it seems like or under-reading a few. But there's some low ones out there, you've just got to leave the ball in the right spots so you can be aggressive on the putts.

**Q. Thoughts on the course conditions, because you had to play it down today. Were there any mud balls out there? How was it?**

**BRANDT SNEDEKER:** Surprisingly, no. I think the course held up pretty well. The greens were definitely a little faster today, they had a little bit more bounce to them than they did the first two days, so kind of a little bit more of a defense for the golf course. But fairways were running out pretty good. I didn't see any mud balls, I didn't have any, so bodes well for the guys in the afternoon.

**Q. If you go to PGATOUR.com right now, you can see the video of Austin caddying for you on Wednesday in the pro-am. How cool was that? I know he tried to pick up the bag. It was a little heavy for him, wasn't it?**

**BRANDT SNEDEKER:** A little too heavy for him. You know, it definitely weighs more than he does right now. Have to wait a few years, beef him up a little bit, get him on a program, get him ready to go. But it was a lot of fun. I got to caddie for him a couple times in a couple junior events he's played in and it was cool to have him out there with me. It's not too often you get to bring your kid out here, have him enjoy the workday with him a little bit, so it was a lot of fun.
