Swing was feeling a lot better and also made a lot of putts, so it was a good round.

Q. I was going to say, 125 feet worth of putts for you, including that fist pump you gave us at 18. That was a great par from there.

JOAQUIN NIEMANN: Yeah, that was a big par there. And 18th hole is a really tough one. It's a really tough tee shot, and the second shot also is really tricky hitting downhill and going up. So yeah, I mean, it was a really good up-and-down. I'm really happy for this week, I hopefully get a good week next one.

Q. You came into the week 84th in the FedExCup standings, but right now you project inside the Top-70, which is great for not only next week, but the week after that.

JOAQUIN NIEMANN: Yeah, of course. I mean, obviously it's an important week, this one, so you don't have to be thinking about next week to get into the Top-70. So this will help a lot for next week and don't have that pressure of playing really good, so I feel a lot better now.
