Q. I think you just said it, man, back nine.

TIM PETROVIC: Yeah, if I could have just played the back nine all week, I think it would have been fine. It would have been an easy victory. Just haven't figured out that front nine this week. Got out of the gates and skulled probably the easiest wedge shot I had all day and hit it over the green from 83 yards. It was just a crazy shot. You know, kicked myself in the butt and regrouped and start making some putts on the back.

Q. I saw at the end there you two pointing at each other. Were you going back and forth there?

TIM PETROVIC: Oh, no, that goes back to Dick's. I made a birdie on 18 on him there and beat him by a shot, so I was glad he made that. If you could hear me when he hit his putt, I was going, "Get in, get in." That's why he pointed at me.

Q. Overall, can you just wrap up the week and being here, the second year of the tournament being here and the course and the tournament itself?

TIM PETROVIC: Yeah, we all love this course. It's one of our classic courses. We played it many years on the PGA TOUR and I haven't been here in probably nine years. Coming back last year, some guys hadn't been here in probably 15 or so years. So it's one of our good golf courses, one of our favorites. I just, I think I shot 11 under here in '09 when Tiger won it, the last one, but I didn't realize he went 20 under.
