Q. Four under on the final round is a great way to finish at Warwick. Were you pleased with that round?

DAVID TOMS: Yeah. I was actually kind of in between clubs, I didn't know what to hit. I had hit it over the green yesterday and so I went ahead with the shorter club and hit it really solid and I got in there about 20 feet underneath the hole.
